Thank you for your faithful prayers! There have been developments in several areas:

- We had a change of plans in regards to the youth camp location. Somehow, the owner of the property we were going to rent heard that “wazungu” (white people) were involved. Because of severe misunderstandings about the wealth of whites, he decided to raise the price by over three times what was agreed on. We have been able to find another property—please pray for God’s perfect plan.

- The church work day went well as we built a building for the church plant in Naivasha. Their first service will be November 10th.

- We have been asked to teach a different SS class since the group of boarding school students has been smaller. We started with the older youths (we would call it “college and career”) class last Sunday. We are very excited about this opportunity to impact those who are looking into marriage, seeking direction in life, and looking for truth. We are burdened to see them know and love the Lord!

- We appreciate your continued prayers for the Bible translation project. Decisions about the future of the project will be made in the next couple weeks.

- The medical team has arrived. We will be setting up clinics in four separate locations. Nathanael will be translating for those seeing the eye doctor.

- We have several groups of visitors coming in November and December. Please pray for us as we have the privilege of hosting these people. Linette is trying to wrap up the kids’ school year despite the impact our furlough had on the school work and required days, so it’s been busy at home! 😊
- Linette has also been putting a lot of time into preparing lessons for the teachers of Wednesday night kids’ clubs. We are glad to help prepare the curriculum and teach each week. Both of our classes have many community children that we have grown to love and care for. They are truly a mission field. Many of you all are involved in reaching the children in your communities as well—those who do not have godly, loving, or safe homes. Keep showing them Jesus. Keep hugging. Keep loving. Keep singing. Keep bringing snacks. 😊 Keep working on those lessons. We will reap if we faint not.
