Boozhoo (Ojibwe for "Hello"),

Family

Thank you to everyone that prayed for my wife during her pregnancy and for a safe delivery! My wife gave birth to LuciEmma Ruth Hope Roembke on November 7 at 2:11 P.M. She weighed 9lbs 4ozs and 20.5 inches long. She may sound big but she is actually the smallest full-term baby my wife has delivered! Please continue to pray for my wife's recovery and for baby to continue to adapt to this life. LuciEmma's siblings are all amazed with her!

We will be traveling to Indiana Thanksgiving week for about a month. During this month we will be able to visit with family during the holidays but most importantly my wife will be able to continue to recover and focus on taking care of the baby. My mother-in-law, who has sacrificed her time to help us the last couple of weeks at our home, will help the girls with their schooling while we are down in Indiana. We are very thankful for her help! I will be in Indiana for part of the time as I will fly back to Minnesota in the middle of December to take care of the ministry needs then fly right back for Christmas. After Christmas, we as a whole family will travel back to Minnesota. Pray for us as we adjust to having six kids six and under. We are extremely blessed with children from the Lord!

Outreach

Over the last year, the towns of White Earth and Ogema have been canvassed with gospel tracts and church invites multiple times. In October, we were able to start to get the gospel in the town of Waubun which is 15 minutes northwest of the town of White Earth. We still have about half the town to reach. Pray that we will see fruit out of those that have received John & Romans and for those we still need to reach in Waubun.

Instead of celebrating Halloween with the rest of the world, we at Hope Baptist celebrated Hallelujah Night on October 31 by singing praises to the Lord, preaching the gospel from John 5:24, and a candy buffet! We were hoping for quite a few guests but the Lord blessed with a couple new guests. Our faithful attendees were there along with two people returning who have not been to the services in a while. We had a great time and the gospel was preached. Pray for a lady named Joanie, who has been fairly faithful to the services since Hope Baptist was started. She is not saved and she indicated that after the gospel message on Hallelujah Night. She has recently opened up to us how she is holding on to Native traditions and talking about medicine men for healing. Pray that she will get saved and that she will find a true identity in Jesus Christ!

In January Lord willing, we will be doing a 12-week addiction outreach on the reservation. There are many that are wholly given to addictions that are taking peoples lives in White Earth and the surrounding native towns. I have wanted to run an addiction ministry for quite awhile but have never had the green light from the Lord. The Lord has allowed me to have a short-term focus on reaching the addicts in our area for the winter season. I would love it to be long term but the Lord would have to provide more help to keep it going. Who knows the Lord may just save some addicts that would be future helpers and leaders! Pray for this addiction outreach would be very effective and the gospel will reach souls for Jesus! Pray that the Hope Baptist would grow through this with new disciples. I will keep you all updated with this outreach as we start and get into it.
